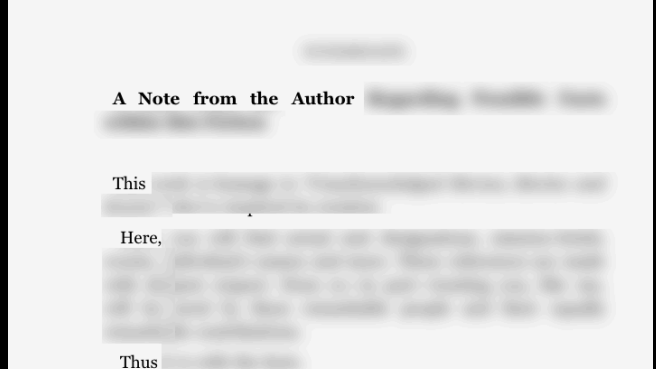
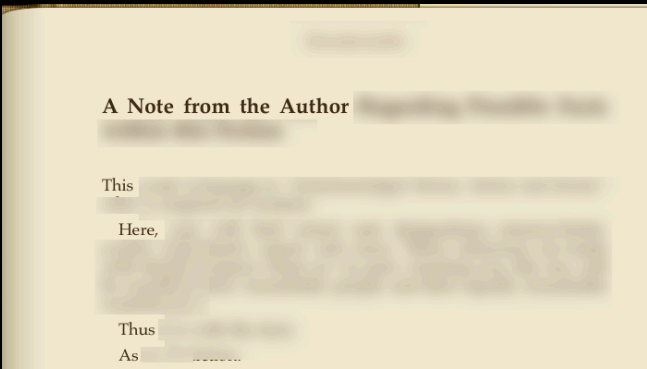
Kindle Version

Problem



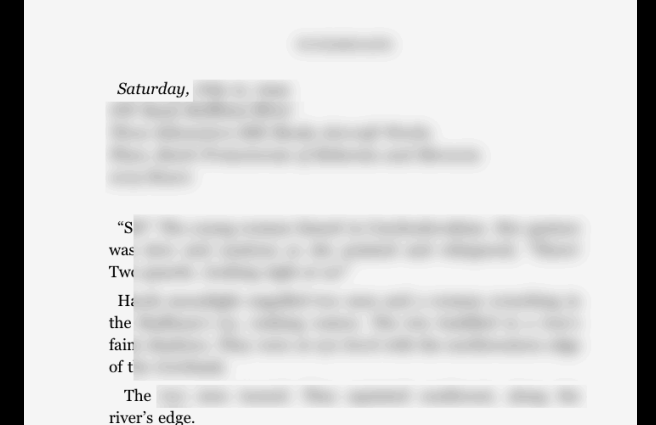
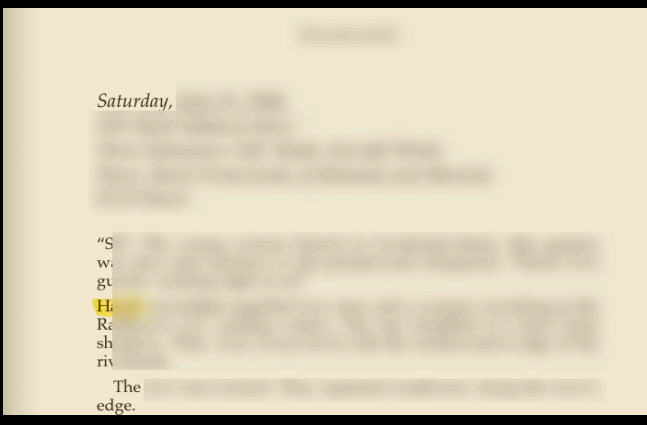
Kindle version correctly applies center formatting on "Novel by..."

ePub version left-justifies "Novel by..."



In spite of attempts to format all text first lines with zero indent and fully justified, the Kindle version has slight first line indent.

The ePub version correctly applies first line—zero indent.



In spite of attempts to format the "Day, Date, Location" block with zero indent, the Kindle version has a slight indent. The first line of a new section has been formatted with zero indent, yet the Kindle has indented the first line. All subsequent first lines are formatted with a slight indent.

The ePub version correctly applies zero indent to the "Day, Date, Location" block. It also correctly applies the zero-indent to the first paragraph; HOWEVER, it incorrectly applies the zero-indent to the second paragraph (and yet it correctly applies the desired "non-first paragraph" indent to the third paragraph).
