9. I copy-paste sentence in point 7 and reintroduce the italics: *"cuanto hay de rechazo, de indignación o de deterioro en la sociedad como consecuencia de su conducta"*<sup>12,13</sup>.
10. I copy-paste the sentence in point 8 reintroduce the italics: *"ni siquiera se podrían explicar con ese cheque de 600.000 dólares de que se habla, y cuyo cobrador seguramente no ha aparecido con su verdadera cara en la ventanilla del banco"*.<sup>14</sup>
11. "Trying to reproduce the double punctuation issue".<sup>15</sup>
13. "Trying to reproduce the double note number issue: mayus+f5 inspector footnote"<sup>16</sup>.
