

## Example

The following paragraphs have been created with a font that supports true Small Caps: *Linux Libertine, 24 pt*. This is the original text:

I want to include some words using all small caps: nsa, fbi, as well as a mixture of caps and small caps: Let's be Friends.

## Case 1

### *Synopsis*

Applied «Convert to Small Caps» to words of interest (fake small caps)

### *Text*

I want to include some words using all small caps: NSA, FBI, as well as a mixture of caps and small caps: LET'S BE FRIENDS.

### *Notes*

In this case words with fake caps look OK on the editor, but at compile time fake caps are reverted to full sized caps.

## Case 2

### *Synopsis*

Applied Small Caps from «Typography» settings (true small caps)

### *Text*

I want to include some words using all small caps: nsa, fbi, as well as a mixture of caps and small caps: Let's be Friends.

### *Notes*

In this case words with true small caps look OK on the editor, but at compile time fake caps are reverted to original case.

### Case 3

#### *Synopsis*

Same as Case 2, but with preserve formatting as well.

#### *Text*

I want to include some words using all small caps: NSA, FBI, as well as a mixture of caps and small caps: LET'S BE FRIENDS.

#### *Notes*

In this case words with true small caps look OK on the editor as well as on the compile output.
